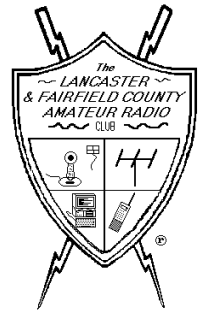

ICS is used to manage an emergency event or a non-emergency event. It can be used equally well for both small and large situations.

Perry County Amateur Radio Club is hosting a Level One ICS class and would like to invite everyone to attend.

It will be presented by Joe Agriesti, a certified instructor with the Ohio Fire Academy and a licensed amateur radio operator.

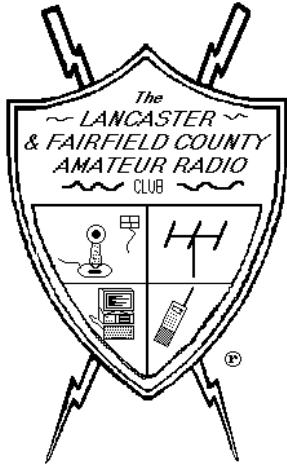
