

IN THE MATTER OF Authorization of use of county property by  
Amateur Radio Club

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 92-07.21.i, the Fairfield County Board of Commissioners granted to the Lancaster Fairfield County Amateur Radio Club use of space at the county's Granville Pike tower site to locate its radio repeater equipment at no cost or liability to the county, and

**WHEREAS**, the Lancaster Fairfield County Amateur Radio Club has provided many decades of service to our community by assisting in various activities and emergency responses with a goal of assisting local officials during times when vital communications are required using its established network of radio operators, and

**WHEREAS**, the Club has been asked to participate in interconnecting its UHF repeater system to the "Central and Southeast Ohio UHF Linked Repeater Network", and

**WHEREAS**, interconnection will permit sharing of information and coordination of disaster activities between Fairfield County and surrounding communities, and

**WHEREAS**, the Club has requested that the Fairfield County Board of Commissioners, the Fairfield County EMA and the City of Lancaster sign the attached agreement to permit the continued use and accessibility of the Granville Pike location for its repeater systems and the interconnection upgrades, and

**WHEREAS**, the Fairfield County Emergency Management Agency has recommended approval, **NOW THEREFORE**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Fairfield, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** that the Board of Commissioners hereby reaffirms Resolution 02-07.21.I and authorizes its President to sign the attached agreement for the continued use of the county's Granville Pike tower site by the Lancaster Fairfield County Amateur Club at no cost or liability to the county.
